The *Tracks Across Wyoming Corridor* encompasses Laramie, Albany, Carbon, Sweetwater, Uinta and southern Lincoln Counties. Within this 400-mile-long area lie prehistoric and historic American Indian migration trails, as well as all or part of the major American migration and transportation routes of the 19th century – the Oregon, California and Mormon Trails, the Pony Express, the Overland stage routes and the nation's first transcontinental railroad. In the early 20th century, the Lincoln Highway (the nation's first coast-to-coast automobile route) and the nation's first air mail service route traversed the corridor. Today, a main artery in the nation's interstate system – Interstate 80 – passes through the same territory.

The corridor is rich in historic and cultural sites and stories associated with all these routes. Our mission is to preserve those sites and tell those stories to the visitors who pass through the corridor's communities.

Tracks Across Wyoming, Inc., is a partnership of southern Wyoming organizations, businesses, government agencies, and individuals. Our members include municipalities, chambers of commerce, museums, visitors' bureaus, and private businesses throughout the southern Wyoming corridor.
